WHEN IS BAND? Welcome to band! 5<sup>h</sup> grade band meets every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 2:30-2:55. Students meet in small group lessons until full band starts on September 30<sup>th</sup>. Please remember to bring your instrument to school these days. If you forget your instrument, you are still required to attend band so you do not miss the lesson material.

WHEN IS MY LESSON? Individual lesson times will be announced Monday, August 30<sup>th</sup>. Keep your instrument in the band room after registration and pick it up after your first lesson. Your lesson will be during regular class time and any classwork you miss while in lessons you are expected to make up.

## **HOW DO I EARN AN 'A' IN BAND?**

· Practice 4 times each week for 15-20 minutes 10 points per week

WHAT IS A PRACTICE RECORD? Every week you fill out a practice record to keep track of when you practice and to keep track of your weekly goals. During the first few weeks of band we

will fill out the practice record in your lesson. When we start to meet for full band we will fill it out as a class. When practicing at home, keep track of which days you practice and for how long. Have a grown up that you live with sign next to 'Parent Signature' every Sunday. I will collect practice records every Wednesday at the start of band. If you lose you practice record, print a new one off of the band website www.arcolamusicdept.org.
